Friday, June 5	<p>Drive-Through Diploma Ceremony with Cap and Gown Photos from Bell Studios. This event will take place on the Columbia County Courthouse steps. Starting at Noon.</p> <p>Seniors, with your families in <u>one vehicle per graduate</u>, will meet at our pre-staging location at your designated time. The SHPD will lead our procession through to the downtown area where each graduate's car will pull up, one by one, in front of the courthouse. The graduate will exit their car, be announced, receive their diploma), and have their picture taken by Bell Studios and then return to their car. Once this is complete the vehicle will exit and you can return home. The graduate needs to be in the <u>passenger seat</u> of the vehicle so that they can exit the vehicle and the vehicle can pull forward while they are no longer in it.</p> <p>You will need to bring the "name tag" that was in your bag from Thursday's pick up as we will have runners coming to get them from the cars waiting to be announced. This prevents us from having to put the cars in any sort of order.... See times below.</p> <p>Dress: You are to wear nice clothing underneath your gowns. Dress pants, dresses, skirts, dress shoes, are all appropriate for this event. Wear your cap, gown, stole, cords, and medals that you have earned from our school organizations for your photo! Have the gown zipped closed before exiting your vehicle. No decorations on your attire for this event. There will be lots of pictures and videos taken of this event, so look nice and be ready. We advise you to wear shoes that are low healed easy to move in as you will be ascending and descending some old steps that may not have a railing.</p> <p>This event is closed to the public. Only SHSD staff will be allowed to be in the town square area for this event so that all social distancing guidelines can be meet. Only <u>1 vehicle per senior</u> will be allowed in the procession so plan for this. Family members can pop out of the vehicle for a quick picture of the graduate on the steps, but should be back in the car before the graduate is back to the car.</p>
