- 4pm Break for Hotel Check-in
- 5pm Dinner at the hotel (Group Dinner: Pizza delivery at our Hotel, provided)

What you need for this trip:

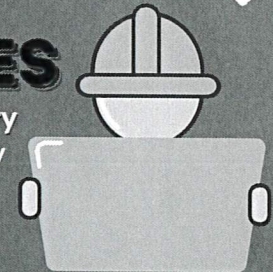

Participant Commitment

Our primary goal is for every student to experience a SAFE and FULFILLING two-days at OASC Spring Conference, *The Building Blocks of Leadership*. We feel strongly that in order for that to happen, each student must take responsibility for their own behavior. The following are rules that must be strictly observed by all participating students:

- We will have a CLOSED SITE each day. Students will NOT be allowed to leave the convention center at any time without adult supervision from their school, or adviser permission to be escorted by Alumni Safety Squad. All Students are required to stay on-site during general sessions, workshops, evening activities, and other OASC sponsored activities. Students not registered with their school for this event will not be allowed to visit (**exception:** student/youth presenters not registered with a school may be on-site during workshop hours or general sessions).
 - **High School Only:** high school students may leave the convention center with adviser permission in groups of 2 or more during times not required to be on-site above.
- The use of Drugs / Alcohol / Tobacco is strictly prohibited.
- Students are expected to show RESPECT for the staff, other students, and for the property, this includes but is not limited to: Seaside Convention Center, Seaside High School, Hotels, Restaurants, Shops, and all other public or private spaces occupied by students throughout the Spring Conference weekend. If there is a concern - report to your adviser/chaperone, an OASC Safety Squad member, OASC Board Member, or Miles Palacios.
- Theft, vandalism, or destruction of property will not be tolerated.
- All student presentations are expected to be in good taste. Profanity and inappropriate jokes will not be tolerated.
- Show up ON TIME and with a POSITIVE attitude to all sessions.
- Bring and Wear APPROPRIATE attire (all major body parts fully covered).
